

Before and After

This is a two part activity. Complete part one prior to the historical society visit and part two after the historical society visit.

Part 1:

On a separate sheet of paper, draw a picture of either an Indian boy or girl who lived in the central Pennsylvania area. Be sure to think about clothing, hair, eyes, skin color, jewelry, and possessions. When you are finished, explain your picture to a partner or share with the class. Be sure to save your picture because you will need it after the historical society presentation.



Part 2:

Take out the picture you drew of the Indian boy or girl. Add to, remove from, or change in some way your picture based on what you learned from the historical society presentation. Share with a partner or the class how you changed your picture.
