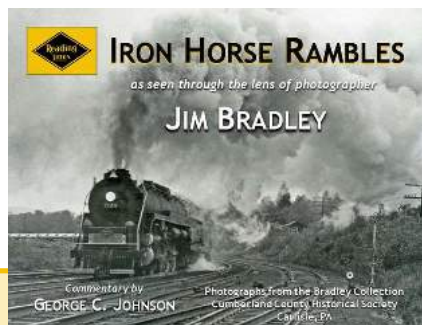

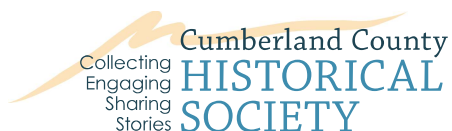
1. Visit all the locations listed.

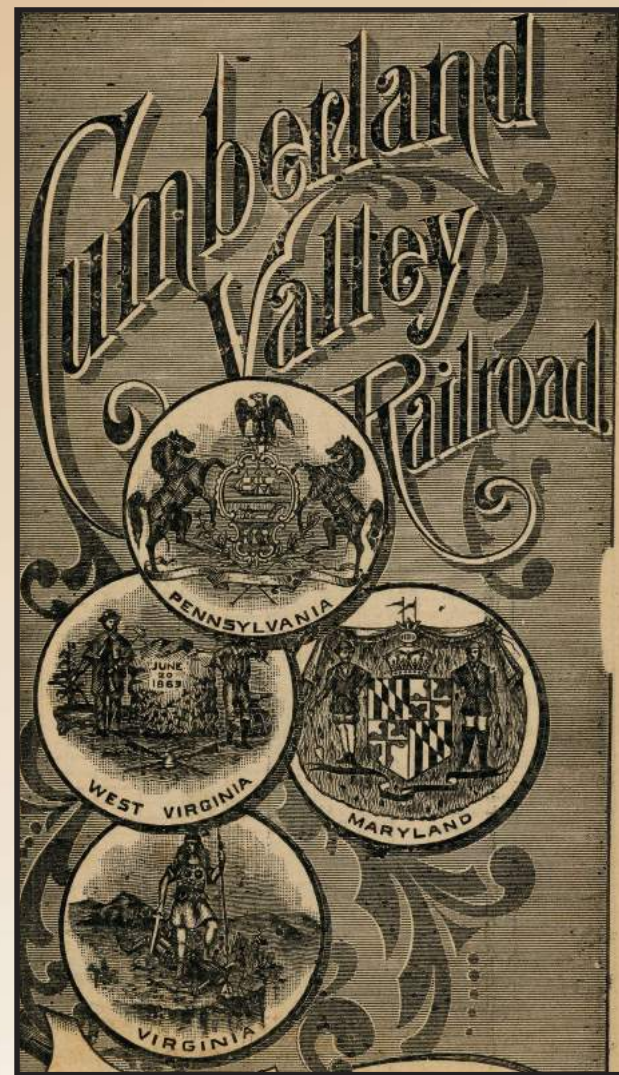
